PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS

Who

Journalists from Belarus, France, Germany, Moldova, Poland, and Ukraine, with experience in print, online media, radio, podcasts, TV, film, or video.

Publications

Participants are required to have a medium for publishing at least three journalistic pieces during the project, including one cross-border collaboration.

Language

Proficiency in English is required. Publications may be made in native languages.

Travel

Participants must have valid travel documents (passport, visa). We offer assistance with visa queries

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Free of Charge: All travel (economy class), accommodation, and meals (mostly vegetarian) will be covered.

Research Funding: Limited reimbursement for cross-border research travel expenses may be available. We also encourage participants to apply for additional grants to support in-depth investigations.
